



# Call for Proposals

## Dallas InnerCity Growers' Summit

- We are excited to share with you the call for proposals for the first annual Dallas InnerCity Growers' Summit on February 20, 2023.
- This year, the overarching theme is “Building Resilient Food Systems” with three sub-themes: 1) Agribusiness, 2) Education and Policy, and 3) Farming Models/Techniques
- We encourage proposals for Keynote sessions, showcase sessions, poster sessions. When submitting a proposal, you may select your preferred format, or you may select all formats to be considered.
  - **Keynote sessions** (30-60 minutes) should help participants create a deeper understanding of a topic related to the conference theme/sub-themes.
  - **Showcase sessions** (1.5 hour) will group 3-5 proposals with similar topics to form a panel discussion. Presenters will give a 10-12 minute introduction with up to 5 slides, followed by time for Q&A.
  - **Poster sessions** (1.5 hour) will provide opportunities for lively discussions between attendees and poster presenters. Presenters will be asked to bring a printed poster (up to 36x4 in size) that showcases their work.
