Re: Transmittal of Available Public Grants Supporting CECAP Implementation

Per request during the September 25, 2020 meeting of the Environment and Sustainability Task Force, we are transmitting the attached summary of available public grants that may be used to support CECAP Implementation.

This summary was developed by the grant team in the City of Dallas Office of Government Partnerships and provides a summary of known public grant opportunities that may be available to the City of Dallas to support CECAP implementation. It should be noted that there may be other public notices of funding availability, by local, state and federal agencies, as well as private foundations and non-governmental organizations such as the Communities Foundation of Texas, The Nature Conservancy, Bloomberg and Rockefeller Foundations, the U.S. Climate Mayors, and others.

Typically, the City evaluates funding opportunities relative to applicability for direct programmatic support, the ability to effectively partner with multiple departments or agencies, time-frame and other requirements for implementation, and grant-specific requirements relative to administrative and reporting requirements and matching fund requirements/availability. Time frame available for response is often evaluated relative to required staff resources for response.
