

VAPING ORDINANCE FAQ SHEET

1. About the Ordinance

Q What does the new ordinance do?

A Adds vaping/electronic smoking devices to smoking ordinances and updates smoking signage.

3. Indoor Limits

Q Is vaping indoors allowed?

A Vaping is not allowed in any public indoor areas. For example: elevators, retail shops, hospitals and schools.

2. Outdoor Limits

Q Where is vaping not allowed?

A Any place where smoking is currently not allowed. For example: parks, playgrounds, and restaurants.

4. Smoking Devices

Q Does the ordinance include cigarettes?

A Yes. Cigars, cigarettes, electronic smoking devices, and pipes are also included.

5. Signage

Q Who is required to have new signage?

A Any owner, operator, or person in control of an area where smoking/vaping is currently not allowed.

VAPING ORDINANCE FAQ SIGNAGE SHEET

1. Indoor & Outdoor Signs

Q Where should signs be posted?

A Outdoor signs should be placed conspicuously at main entrances and indoor signs placed conspicuously at each entrance.

3. Required Language

Q What should the sign say?

A Outdoor signage must say, "No Smoking within 15 Feet of Entrance, City of Dallas Ordinance." Indoor signage must say, "No Smoking, City of Dallas Ordinance."

4. Ordinance Number

Q Does the ordinance number need to be on the sign?

A No. The ordinance number is not required to be on the sign.

2. Symbols

Q What symbol is required?

A Any universal symbol for no smoking or use of an electronic smoking device can be used.
